We will begin with a corporate worship service on Wednesday night and continue with day sessions on Thursday and Friday. On Saturday, November 3<sup>rd</sup> we will assemble in downtown Atlanta for our 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Pro-Love March (www.pro-love.org), an initiative designed to bring together white and black, Christian and Muslim, gay and straight, to encourage coexistence and unity.
