When you are a seeker of truth it is not unusual to find yourself unsure and afraid, even feeling alone. As a minister and leader, you have doubtless discovered that the authentic journey toward truth is an unending one and will inevitably lead you to places where those surrounding you have not ventured and cannot yet go. If any of this describes you... you're actually not alone! Many of us, from an array of different ministries and diverse backgrounds, have desired to have a place to exchange ideas in an open and safe forum without the fear of losing our churches, network connections or organizational coverings – the **COMMUNION of CHRIST-CONSCIOUSNESS** (CCC) is designed to connect leaders who want to expand their influence, their networks and their minds.

The purpose of this Communion is to allow progressive spiritual leaders, from various streams, to come together to discuss their innermost thoughts and ideas without fear of penalty. The CCC is established in openness, tolerance and peace.

Our inaugural gathering will be **DECEMBER 8th and 9th, 2009**, at the “NEW” Cathedral of the Holy Spirit in Decatur, GA. The day sessions will include a variety of topics – from Inclusion to Oneness – and each session will encourage group dialogue and a round table discussion.

WEDNESDAY NIGHT, DECEMBER 9th at 7:30 p.m. – **Bishop Carlton Pearson** will be ministering at the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit - all CCC conferees are invited to attend this service!

The conference fee is only **\$50.00** and includes 2 days of breakfast, lunch and all conference materials (dinner on your own). If you can only attend a portion of the sessions or meals we can prorate the fee for you. Please RSVP to ladonna.diaz@mycathedral.org if you are planning to attend and include the number of people in your group (as it helps us to plan for meals and materials). If you are flying in from out of state please notify us of any pick up and transportation needs. For hotel information please contact the Cathedral office at 404-243-5020 and ask for LaDonna Diaz. We suggest staying in one of the hotels annexing Stonecrest Mall (Hilton Garden Inn, Hyatt Place or Amerisuites) so that we might travel as a group for those needing transportation. Please check “priceline” for best rates before booking hotel. Also, tell the hotel staff you are “clergy” – they usually offer a discount. If you are flying in from out of town and wish to stay in a hotel near the airport we can also help with transportation.

If you desire licensing, ordination or covering from the CCC let us know in advance so that we may prepare the appropriate documents and make plans for the ceremony. Also, bring any business cards, ministry information or products to make available to the rest of the Communion.

We anticipate a powerful time of Revelation, Impartation and Transformation!
